### Minutes

Thirteen members were present: Lee Palmer, Mike & Diane Bunkers, Dennis & Diane LeBrun Dave & Deb Wolles, Jacque Brown, Mike & Sherri Wolles, Mark & Jo Lee and Renae Mergen.

Opening prayer was led by Lee. Secretary and treasurer's reports read. Deb made motion, seconded by Jo to approve both reports.

#### **Old Business:**

- a. Breakfast – the entire breakfast profit was given to the “drum line” fund. A check was given to the band account for \$2110 which included the free will donation along with the booster club's matching funds. Mrs. Smith now has enough money to purchase the drums needed.
- b. Sweatshirts/t-shirts update – Lee passed around the design rules which have changed some. The contest will end on April 30 and we will vote on it during May meeting.
- c. Tour de Kota – will wait and see what the Chamber and Trail Committee decides to do for the arrival day in Dells. It was decided that we would not do anything at the end of the ride as the riders would be packing up and most likely would not stay for anything. Scrambled egg tortillas and/or sweet rolls were suggested. Tabled until the next meeting. Renae suggested having pictures of the St. Mary students on sticks. These sticks would be placed in the ground (maybe at the FB practice field) or somewhere on the bike route with a sign saying “St. Mary Welcomes You to Dell Rapids.”

#### **New Business:**

- a. Playground Equipment – Jacque asked for a donation from the booster club for playground equipment. At the present time, they have \$16,000 with the total cost being \$27,556. They plan to sell the existing equipment on the school carnival. Jo motioned and Mike W. seconded that the booster club donate what is still needed after the equipment is sold. Motion passed. Renae also suggested that they ask the school administration for a “no uniform day” for the SM students in which students bring a \$1 or more and in return are allowed to wear a non -uniform on a specified day. This money would go also go towards the playground equipment fund.
