

## **St. Mary Catholic Schools Booster Club Meeting September 5, 2012 at Jabberwock**

The meeting was called to order by Sue Ann Mullaney with eleven members present: Sue Ann Mullaney, John/Laura Vortherms, Dennis/Diane LeBrun, Sherri Wolles, Peggy Maxwell, Barb Glazier, Diane Bunkers, Rose Brown and Michelle Brown.

**Secretary and Treasurer Reports** read and approved.

### **Old Business:**

- a. **Potato Sales at Bazaar** – still looking for one person to help get the potatoes. Members signed up to sell the potatoes from 8 am to Noon.
- b. **AED Update** – Sue Ann reported that the school kitchen has one AED near the hand washing sink that is used for both the elementary school and the gym area, the FB and BBB team has one that travels with them and there is one located in the church hall foyer for parish use. The middle school is in need of one and it was also decided that it would be beneficial to have one in the gym also. Pat Mullaney learned through Dr. Dave Erickson that Avera would cover half the cost of one AED. The cost of AED is \$1195 and the case \$190 for a total of \$1385. Sue Ann will check with Mrs. Merkwon to see if the school would be interested in purchasing one with Avera and perhaps the Booster Club would cover the cost of a second. Sue Ann will also check to see if Avera would consider covering half of a second AED. No further action taken at this time – tabled until next meeting.
- c. **Half Pot Sign Up** – will resend email to get all FB games covered.
- d. **Post-game party at Event Center** – Sue Ann stated that rent for event center's (north area) would be \$100 plus the guarantee of a \$500 bar tab. It was decided this was too expensive and that we will not have a planned post-game party after the ORR FB game on Sept. 14.
- e. **Tailgater help** – Laura is need of people to move picnic tables to the FB field area for the Homecoming tailgater on Sept. 28.

### **New Business:**

- a. **Advertising (signage requests)** – Sue Ann reported that Dave & Diane Hansen had contacted her regarding the advertising signs in the gym. They would like to give advertisers the option to upgrade their sign to a larger (4 in. taller & 20 in longer) sign for a cost or they can stay with their current smaller sign. They would be having the signs made through the Signarama Company. Discussed and it was decided to go with whatever the Hansens thought was best.
- b. **Washington Pavilion (Off the Fridge Art Display)** - Peggy Maxwell asked for a \$350 donation to go toward the elementary art display at Washington Pavilion. Diane L. motioned, seconded by Barb G. to donate the \$350. Peggy stated that the Booster Club has sponsored this project for the past 8 years.
- c. **Homecoming Float** – Plan to decorate the Sunday before the parade. Laura will check with Dells Elevator to see if available for float building and Dave/Deb Wolles have the flatbed. Laura will check with Kristy at school about printing pictures for the float.

- d. **Coach Flemmer at 98 wins** – discussed possible ways to celebrate his 100<sup>th</sup> win. Michelle will look into t-shirt idea and Diane L. will look into getting a plaque made.

**Open Business:**

- a. **Porta Potty for FB field** – Laura reported on the need for at least one more porta potty at the FB field. There was only one in the park for the first game and it was well used and there was a definite need for another. Laura will check into getting another one at the expense of the Booster Club.

**Correspondence:** Laura read a “thank you” from the Junior Achievement for our monetary donation.
