

St. Mary Catholic Schools Booster Club Meeting

Secretary & Treasurer Reports read and approved.

Old Business:

- a. Bylaw Update: Jo Lee motioned that we remove the bylaw that states the booster club donates \$1500 annually to be dispersed between all extra-curricular activities equally. It was seconded by Dennis, motioned passed.
- b. Carnival donation: booster club will donate two separate packages each containing an activity pass along with a free pop & popcorn for each game and a choice of a sweatshirt or shirt from the spirit wear.

New Business:

- a. Senior post prom request: Rachel Scholten, senior class president, asked for a donation of \$1000 to be used for post prom activities. Diane B. motioned, seconded by Jacque to grant the request. Motion passed.
- b. Golf request: Justin Brunick, SM golf coach, requested four golf bags for a cost of \$109.95 each which includes embroidery of logo and/or team name. These would be used for varsity players. He also requested polo shirts at a cost of \$36 each for JV and varsity golfers. Renae motioned to purchase the bags and shirts with the understanding that the golf team and their parents would help with the upcoming booster club breakfast on March 3. Motion passed. At this time there are not any girl golfers, but we will purchase shirts for any that may join in the future. Mr. Brunick also thanked the booster club for his 1% stipend he recently received.
- c. Junior Achievement request: Pat requested \$275 which would include \$250 for the program and \$25 for golf hole sponsorship. Peggy motioned to donate the \$275, seconded by Laura. Motion passed.
- d. Breakfast – booster club breakfast is March 3. Jacque asked officers to email BC members and golf team & parents asking for one dozen muffins or rolls. Workers can come at 7:30 am or later in the morning to help with clean up.
- e. Spirit wear t-shirt contest – discussed holding another contest. It was decided to do this every 3 – 5 years.
- f. Activity banquet – Sue Ann questioned the booster club's role in the banquet. The booster club has not been involved with this for the past couple years.

Open Business:

- a. Pep rally: it was stated there will be a pep rally at the school this Thursday at 8:40 am. Everyone is encouraged to attend and support Leon Maxwell who will be heading to State wrestling and the girls' and boys' basketball team as they head into district games. Peggy stated that the state wrestling meet will be televised.
