- c. Spirit Wear Sales** – Made \$800 on first webstore and additional \$400 for selling in-stock merchandise and samples.
- d. Membership** – Current membership is 97 individual/family and 47 businesses.

- f. **Coacting Certification Reimbursements** – Helen motioned and Suzanne seconded to reimburse the coaches for their recertification. The total expense is \$210. Motion passed.
