

**Booster Club Meeting Agenda  
September 10, 2018 – 6:30pm

Opened with prayer. Wendy read minutes, two names were changed and they were approved. Diane gave treasurer's report.

**I. Old Business**

**a. Senior banners** – Jason presented the proposal from the banner committee. A document entitled, “Booster Club Senior Banners” was shared with the members. This document provides the guidelines and form for the seniors to fill out to get this gift from the BC. After making some modifications to the original document, Peggy motioned to accept the BC Senior Banner proposal to provide each senior with a banner if they so choose. Cami seconded and the motion passed. The banners will hang on the west wall of the gym. The cost of the banners is \$30 each.

**II. New Business**

**a. Off the Fridge** – Peggy Maxwell asked for \$350 to fund the PreK & Kindergarten artwork to be displayed at the Washington Pavilion. Casey motioned to approve the request and Karey seconded. Motion carried.

**b. Coaching classes** – Casey reported that \$315 was spent for eight coaches' classes.

**c. New Teacher Bonus** – The BC paid a total of \$625 to the two new teachers, Miss Alyssa Brazil and Mrs. Mistie Geraets.

- d. **Potato Sales** – Steph Wolles motioned, and Scott seconded to sell potatoes during the annual Turkey Dinner and the motion passes. Mike and Sherri Wolles volunteered to go and get potatoes for the BC. Sales will be at the east practice field from 7:30 – noon. Help is needed for sales and also to transport unsold potatoes to Dells Elevator. They have graciously agreed to sell during the week.
- e. **Football Tailgator** – Our August 17 tailgator had a profit of \$1047.07. It was a little more difficult to sell the 39 ½ leftover loins. Discussion on how to promote this was held and next year a sign will be displayed at the ticket table to notify people of this. Jeanne asked for help moving and cleaning tables before the Homecoming tailgator.
- f. **Crows Nest in the gym** – Casey requested up to \$200 to have a banner designed for display under the crows nest in the gym. Craig made a motion to approve this request. Kinsey seconded and motion carried.
- g. **Football Field Speaker** – Jeanne said people have approached her about improving the sound system at the football field. Casey and Dave think we might already have the equipment, but it needs to be adjusted and tested. Jason motioned that if the current equipment is not sufficient, up to \$1000 can be used to purchase additional pieces and an additional funding request can be made. Scott seconded and motion was approved.

### Open Business

- a. **Hot dog roller** – Shelly Geraets came with information about hot dog rollers she found on Amazon. She used one when she volunteered at the baseball concession stand. She suggested using it during football games and if people wanted to use it for basketball, it would be available. Jason suggested finding a used, commercial one for sale. Amy Geraets motioned to purchase a new one from Amazon for \$159.95 Cami seconded and the motion carried.
- b. **Calendars** – Deb said the cost of this years calendars was \$333.20.
- c. **Business memberships** – Deb reported on Business memberships. She is still waiting to hear back from 11 businesses about renewing their memberships. There are no new business memberships this year.

- d. **Video screen/tv in gym** – Helen brought up putting another video screen/tv in the gym in the northeast corner. Casey will get pricing information to put in a similar system to the one in the southwest corner. He will have this for the next meeting.
- e. **Sweet corn** – Diane reported the sales this year were \$6138.97. This goes into the football fund.
- f. **Football Crows Nest** – Jason brought up the issue of the lack of space in the current crows nest for all the media and camera equipment that now comes to the games. Also, the railing might need to be replaced. We might need to consider improvements. This is on city property, so discussion needs to happen with them as well.
- g. **Thank yous** – Joni Smith thanked the BC for the funds for the new music shirts. The St. Mary Golf Committee thanked us for being a hole sponsor.
