

Booster Club Meeting Notes
March 23, 2021 – 6:00 PM

Opened with prayer.

Ann read January minutes. Helen motioned to approve minutes as long as the next meeting date (February 24) was updated, the meeting was postponed to March. Joni seconded it. Suzanne gave the treasurer's report. The current balance in the BC checking account is \$98, 738.39. BC breakfast raised \$4,839.

II. New Business

- A. **Post Prom** Macie Brown requested \$1200 to cover the cost of Air Madness (1 ½ hour time slot). This includes all you can eat pizza & pop for 54 kids. Request was approved. Seniors have extra money in their account due to no prom last year. They plan to use a portion of this money for prom t-shirts & meals (Chislic - \$13 per person) and the remaining balance for graduation expenses.
- B. **State B Meals** It was proposed that BC pay for 2 of the meals: \$550 for Buffalo Wild Wings and \$360 for Perkins. Jacque motioned to approve and Joni seconded it. There was a concern brought up regarding cheerleaders not being included in all of the meals and their names not on state t-shirts. It was suggested that we have a standing order going forward for athletes/musicians/cheerleaders who qualify for state so meals/lodging are consistent for all. Mr. Michel said he will provide some options for us to review. Colby thanked everyone for their support during the basketball season & state tournament.
- C. **Band Uniforms** Joni indicated uniforms need to be ordered by April 1, 2021. She is planning to order 50 of them. Uniforms will need to be dry cleaned and the band will cover this cost. Jacque suggested Booster Club match breakfast funds. Mr. Michel motioned to match breakfast funds and Heather seconded it. BC will give a total of \$10,000.
- D. **Science Fair** Mr. Michel requested \$100 on Mr. Bacon's behalf. This money will be used to purchase gift cards for Science Fair awards. Jacque motioned to approve it and Stephanie seconded it.

- A. **Thank You Note** Ann read a thank you note from Mrs. Maxwell and Ms. Brazil for the sponsorship of "Off the Fridge" Art show at the Washington Pavilion.
